## **PASTOR’S NOTE**

Happy Sabbath! As we now go into the holiday season of Thanksgiving and Christmas, I am awed at the blessings that God has provided for me and my family. One of the sayings that I love is, “I am blessed, so I live to bless others.” During this season, we have the opportunity to bless family, friends, and even God through his church. Our church has put together a Christmas Wish List that we do not include in our normal operating budget. If any of them appeal to you, why not give a love offering towards it by indicating it in your offering envelope. Let me share them with you:

Transportation Van for our Elderlies. This is one of my personal wish lists. We have been visiting our elderlies the past few weeks, and some of them have difficulty getting to our church due to transportation. Our elderlies have invested so much in our church. It’s time for us to invest in their needs. (Approx \$25-\$30,000)

Updated Audio & Lighting equipment for the gym – Since we will be using our gym consistently for our church service, we need to upgrade our audio and lighting. With the FCC elimination of certain frequencies, we are needing to buy audio equipment that will meet the current need as well as upgrade the lighting for our stage. (Approx \$20-\$25,000)

New Piano for our Gym. Our Music department has raised \$13,000 for the \$40,000 needed for a new worship Piano for our gym. Let’s continue to make praiseful melodies to God.

Evangelism Christmas Lighting Show – Let us introduce ourselves to our community by setting up a Christmas Lighting show in front of our church in 2022. This takes a year of planning so we have to begin now. (\$5-\$10,000)
