PASTOR'S NOTE

First of all, I want to give a special “Thank You” to everyone who was part of making our Thanksgiving Breakfast a meaningful service. From the inspiring program and the beautiful decorations to the delicious breakfast, all reminded us how blessed we are. Second, what a wonderful opportunity to thank some of our unsung heroes that have faithfully served our church over the years. The reality is, we only scratched the surface. This year, we decided to spotlight our audio media department and a couple of special people for their years of faithful service. However, Loma Linda Filipino Church will not thrive and grow without the tireless efforts of people who serve God out of their love for Him. I want you to know that your efforts do not go unnoticed, for even when no one sees, God sees. We do not serve God to win His favor or salvation, but rather, we serve Him out of our passion and calling as children of God. When we serve Him out of love, it is not duty but honor, and I want to say that it's been an astonishing honor to work hand in hand with you for His glory. Finally, thank you for responding generously during our Thanksgiving service. Envelopes are available in the foyer until the end of the year, or you may simply indicate it in the offering envelope as “Transportation, Audio\Visual, Piano, or Christmas Lights.” What a blessing to invest in God's ministry.

Transportation Van for our Elderlies - Some of our elderlies need transportation to church. It's time for us to invest in their needs. (Approx \$25-\$30,000)

Updated Audio & Lighting equipment for the gym - We need to upgrade our audio and lighting for our stage. (Approx \$20-\$25,000)

New Piano for our Gym - Our music department has raised \$13,000 of the \$40,000 that is needed. Let's continue to make melodies for God!

Evangelism Christmas Lighting Show – Let us introduce ourselves to our community by setting up a Christmas Lighting show in front of our church in 2022. (\$5-\$10,000)
