PASTOR'S NOTE

Matthew 21:13 "It is written," He said to them, "My house will be called a house of prayer." What does this mean? I believe that it signifies that God's children makes prayer a priority in the life of His church. Last Sabbath, we talked about prayer. Prayer forces us to "Patiently Wait, Revere God's Sovereignty, Ask for the Holy Spirit, and Yield to Jesus." And we mentioned that God is not as interested in our resolution, as He is in our transformation. So what kind of transformation do you think God is trying to do with you as you spend time in prayer?

During our 10 Days of Prayer, we heard and felt sincere adoration, confession, thanksgiving, and supplications. Some wished that this did not end. I am excited to share with our church that it will not end. We are continuing our prayer experience by transforming our Midweek Prayer Service into literally a time of prayer like we have been doing. Last Wednesday, we began a Prayer Series entitled, "Praying Through the Life of Jesus," where we study and pray over the scriptural verses that talked about the life of Jesus based on the book, "Desire of Ages" by EG White. I am so excited about this because I believe that this will be transformational in the lives of so many of our members young and old.

Just like the 10 Days of Prayer, we are going to ask different Family Groups to lead like our Children, Youth, Pathfinders, Collegiates, Young Adults, Family Circle, Seniors, Elders, Deacons, Women's Ministry, Sabbath School, etc. I truly believe that a family that prays together, plays together, eats together, and worships together, will grow intimately closer and care for each other. If you haven't yet experienced it, why not challenge yourself to a four-week, five week, or 13 week trial. The Bible says, "Taste and See that the Lord is Good." Maybe you'll be inspired and benefit more than you realize as you see that praying is fun and a vital part of your Christian growing experience. I'll be praying for you!
