PASTOR'S NOTE

Are you a worrier or a warrior? God called us to be warriors, not worriers. Trust the Lord and let Him take care of your worries. Let God, let go, and go fight the good fight of faith. With God's help, we can overcome fear, we can overcome anxiety, we can overcome the works of the devil, and we can overcome the devil himself.

When worry attacks you, remember what Jesus said in Matthew 6:25-27. He said, "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes? Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?"

Fellow warriors in Christ, I do believe that the best remedy for anxiety is to fully trust God and to fully trust that He takes good care of us. Sister White wrote, "God cares for everything and sustains everything that He has created. . . No tears are shed that He does not notice. There is no smile that He does not mark. If we would fully believe this, all undue anxieties would be dismissed. Our lives would not be so filled with disappointment as now; for everything whether great or small, would be left in the hands of God, who is not perplexed by the multiplicity of cares or overwhelmed by their weight. We should then enjoy a rest of soul to which many have long been strangers." – *EGW, Steps to Christ, p. 82*

Sister White also wrote, "It is not work that kills; it is worry. The only way to avoid worry is to take every trouble to Christ. Let us not look on the dark side. Let us cultivate cheerfulness of spirit. – *EGW, Letter 208, 1903.*

I encourage you today to cast all your cares upon Jesus (1 Peter 5:7). Trust that He will take care of you and that He will never ever forsake you. May today's message strengthen your faith in God; the one who holds tomorrow and the one who holds our hands.
