PASTOR'S NOTE

Our speaker today for Religious Liberty Sabbath is Alan J. Reinach. He is the Executive Director of the Church State Council, the religious liberty educational and advocacy arm of the Pacific Union Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, representing five western states: Arizona, California, Hawaii, Nevada and Utah. His legal practice emphasizes First Amendment religious freedom cases, Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and state civil rights laws.

Reinach is also a Seventh-day Adventist minister who speaks regularly on religious freedom topics, and is the host of a nationally syndicated weekly radio broadcast, Freedom's Ring, devoted to religious liberty issues. He is the principal author and editor of "Politics & Prophecy: the Battle for Religious Liberty and the Authentic Gospel." Prior to coming to the Church State Council in 1994, Reinach practiced law in New York City. He is a graduate of the University of North Carolina, and of the State University of New York, with special honors in history.
